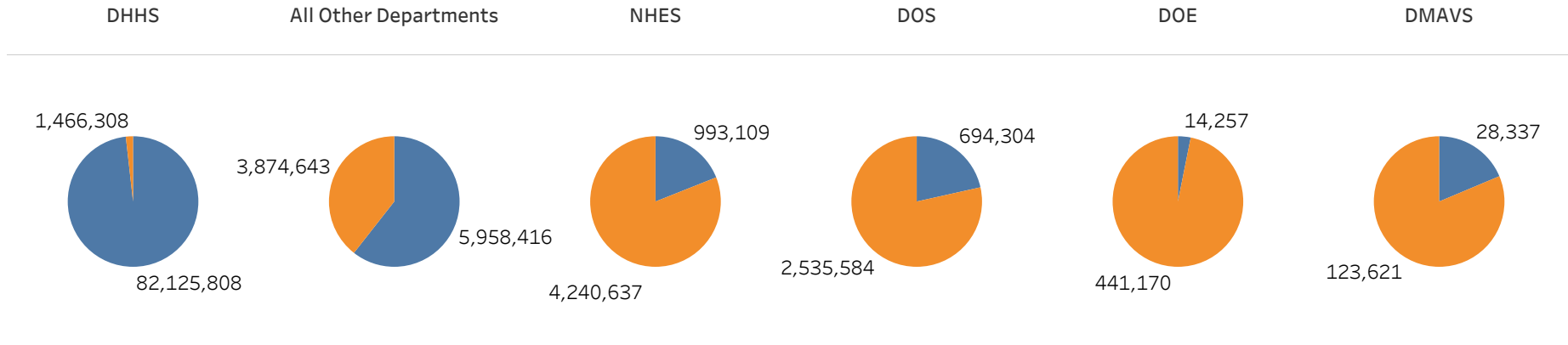

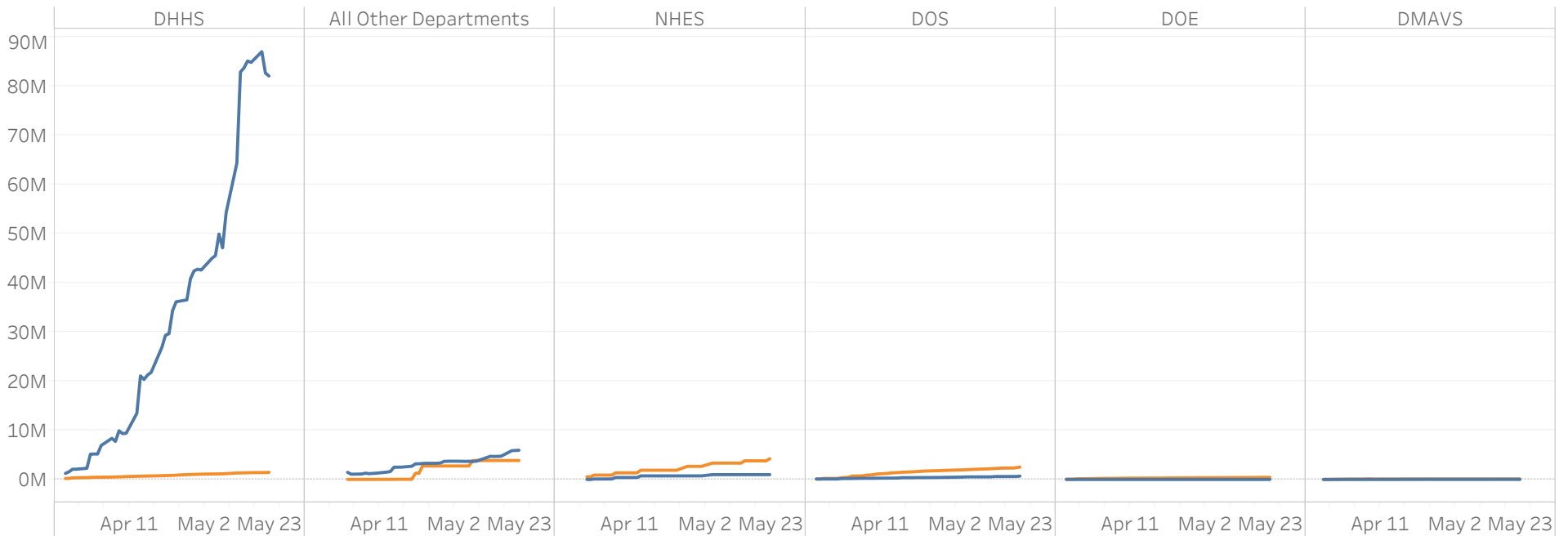

■ Operating Cost ■ Personnel Cost



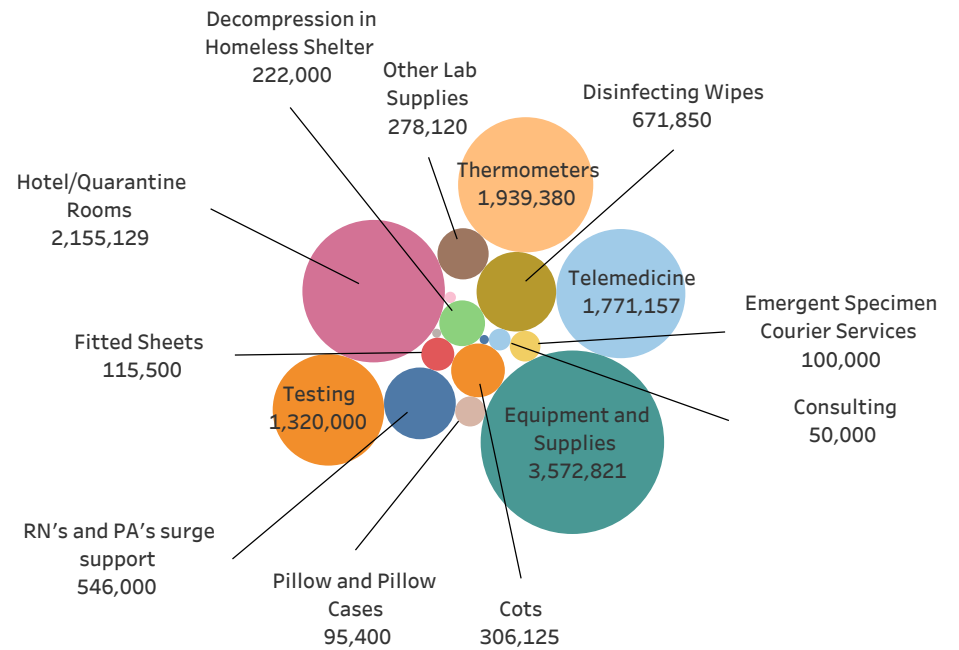
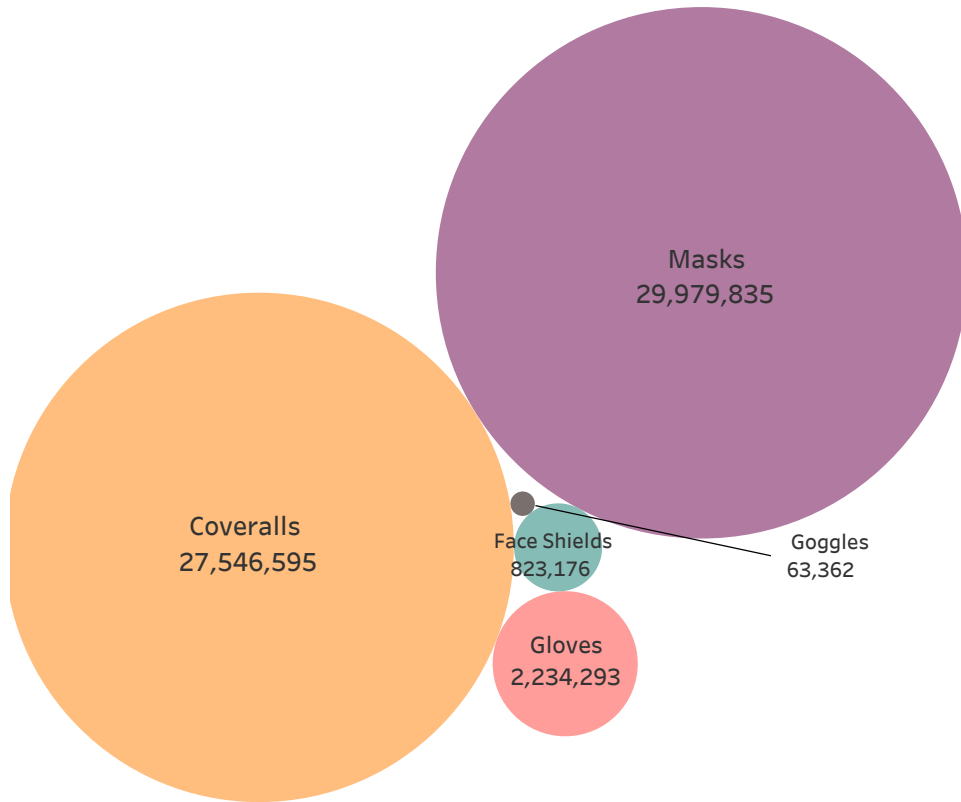

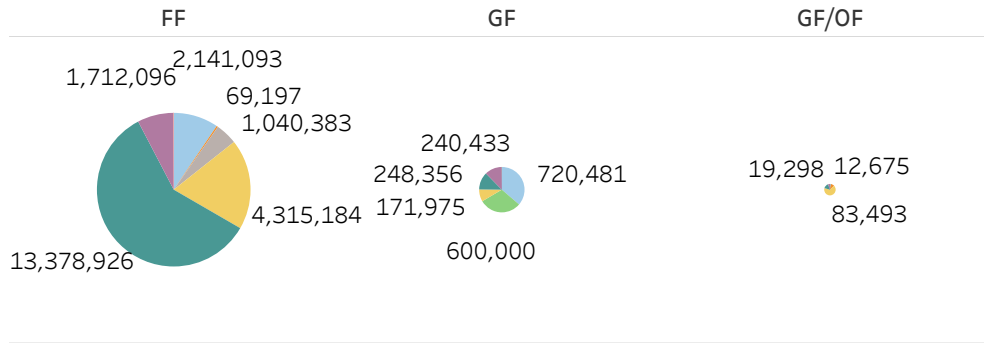

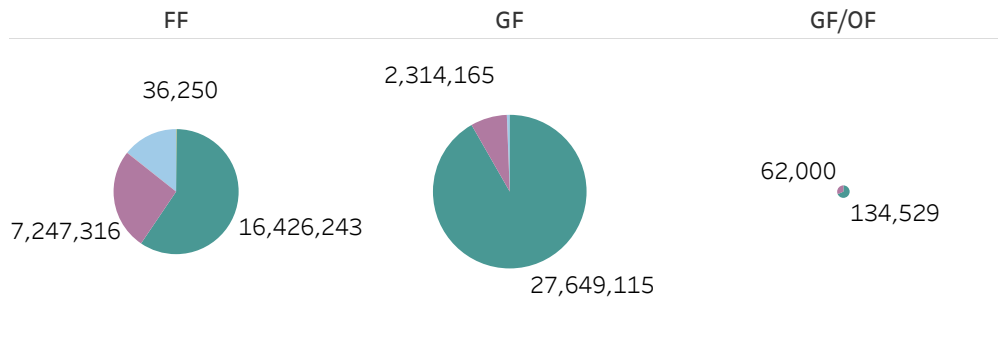
DHHS Financial System Expenses



DHHS Pending Commitments not in the Financial System



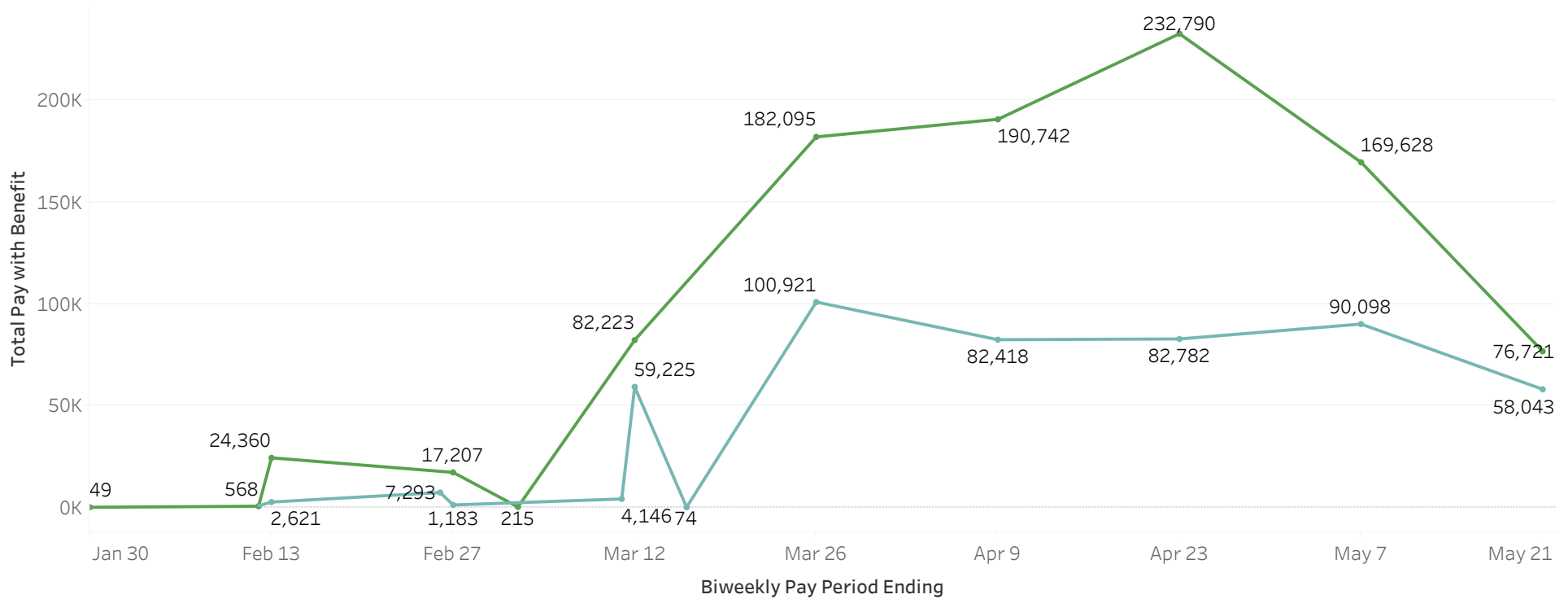
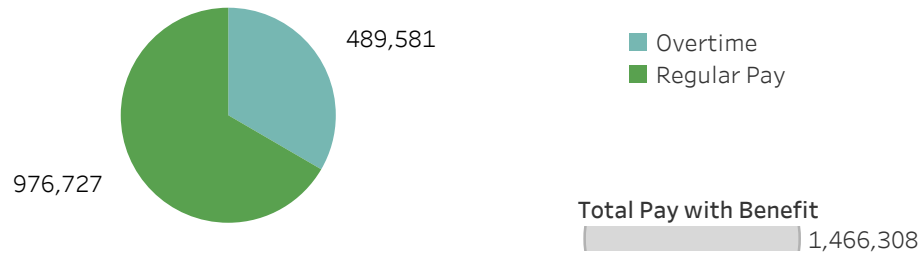
