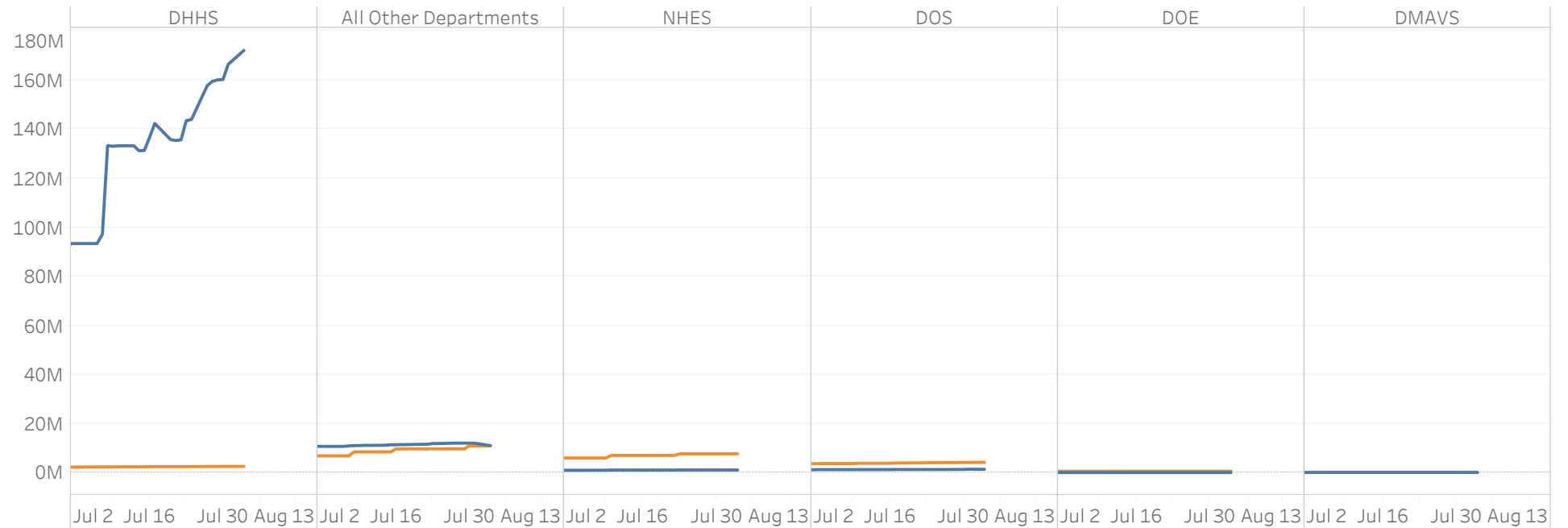

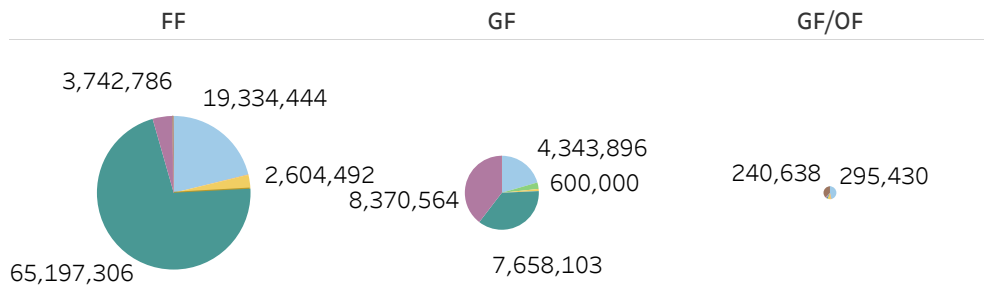

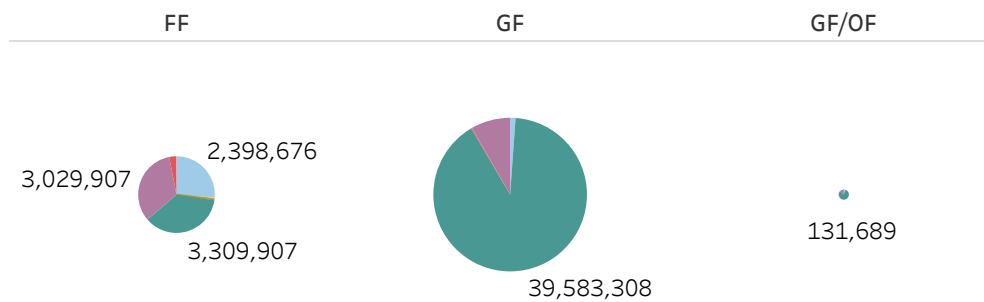

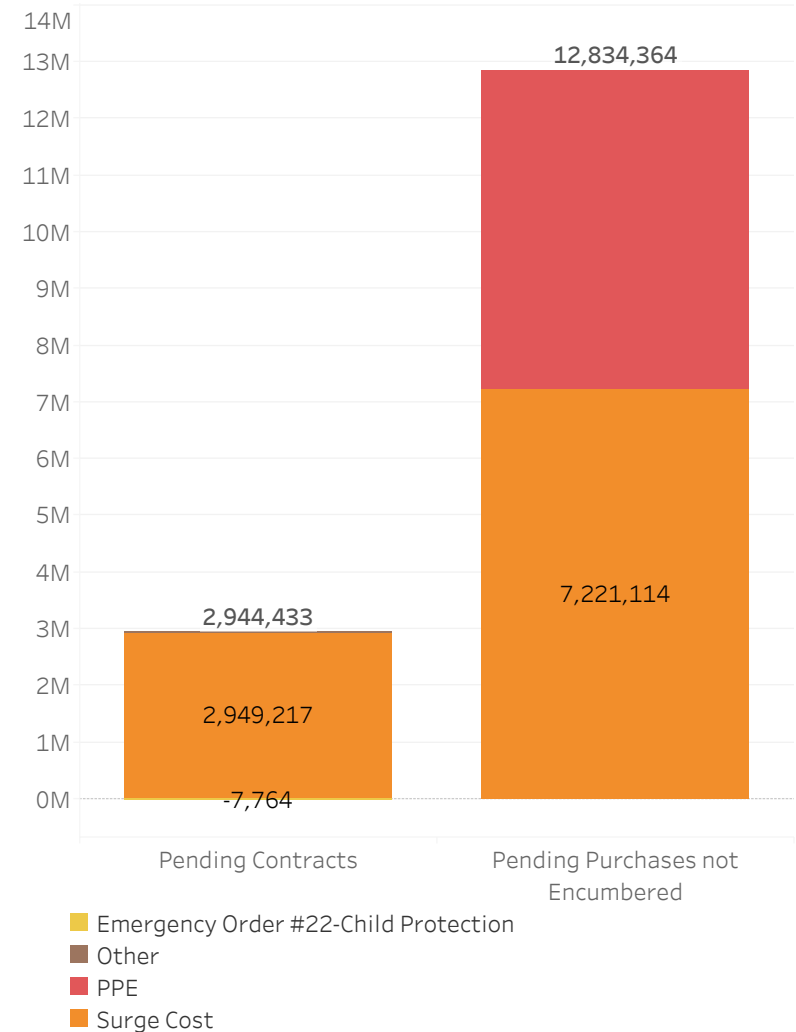

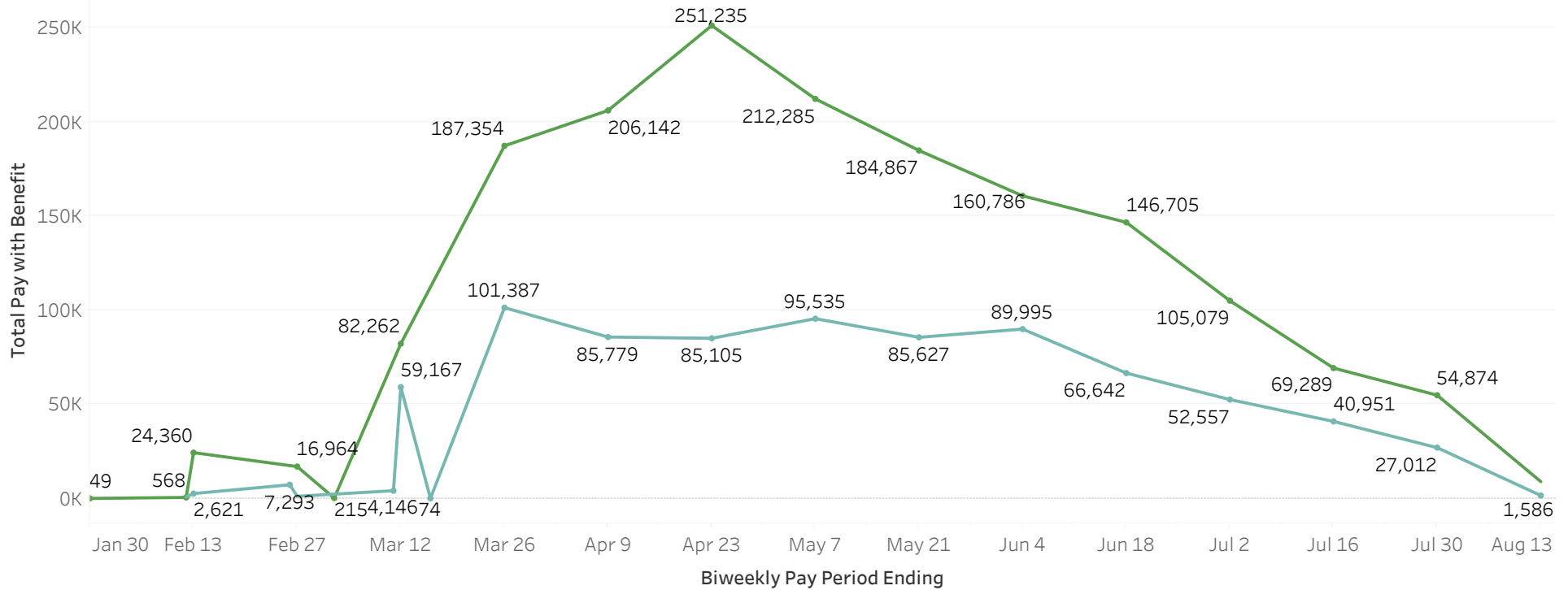
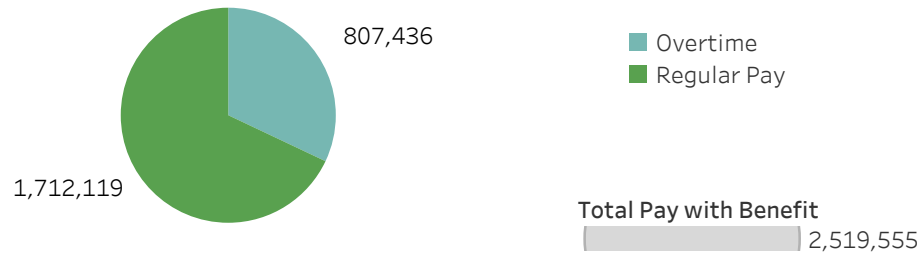
DHHS Pending Commitments not in the Financial System
