EXPLANATION

This request is being made to accept the additional grant funds available for SFY 2021 to administer the Family Violence Prevention and Services Grant Program, Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act). These special funds are to be used to conduct human service activities related to or affected by COVID-19 for services and supports for victims of domestic violence and their dependents.

The NH Coalition and its programs project utilizing the CARES Act funding in the following ways, as is needed by the individual domestic violence program to ensure the continuity of respective program's services:

- Provision of advocacy services, both in-person services and remote services
 - accompaniment to hospital, court, and police departments
 - supportive services and referrals
 - mobile advocacy
- Costs associated with shelter and safe housing
 - Hotel/rental accommodations when shelter space is unavailable
 - Cleaning supplies/cleaning services
 - PPE
 - Rental Assistance

Funds are being budgeted in Program Contracts (Class 103) to provide grant money to New Hampshire programs to carry out the objectives of the Family Violence Prevention and Services. Funds are also being budgeted for Audit costs (Class 041) per state requirements.

Area served: Statewide

Source of Funds: 100% Federal Funds.

If Federal Funds become no longer available, General Funds will not be requested to support the program expenditures.
