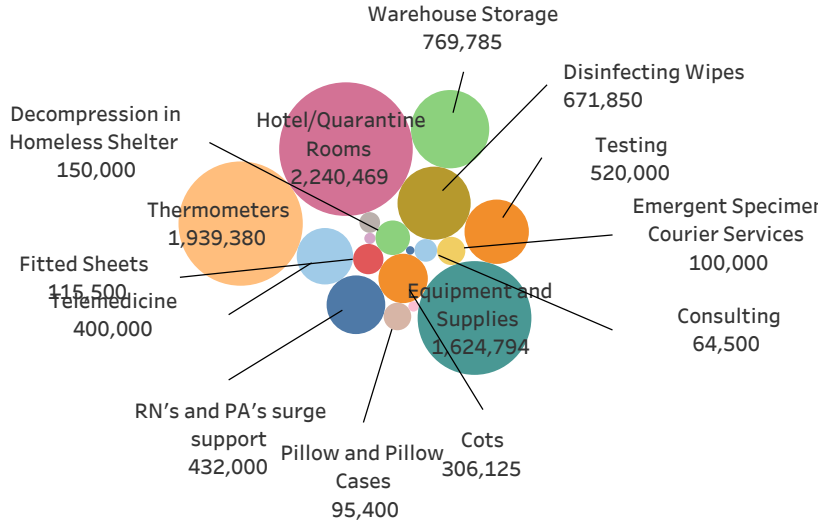

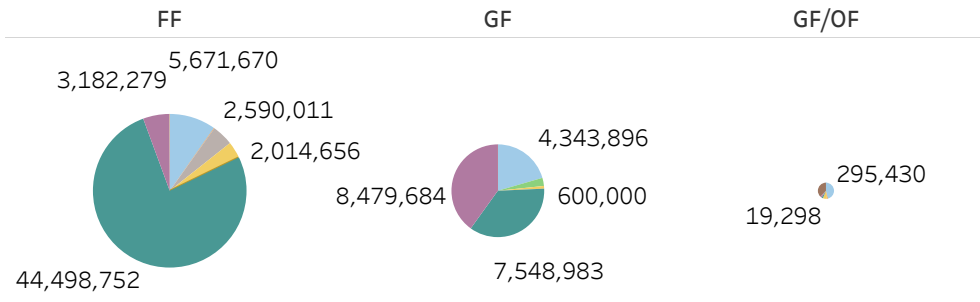

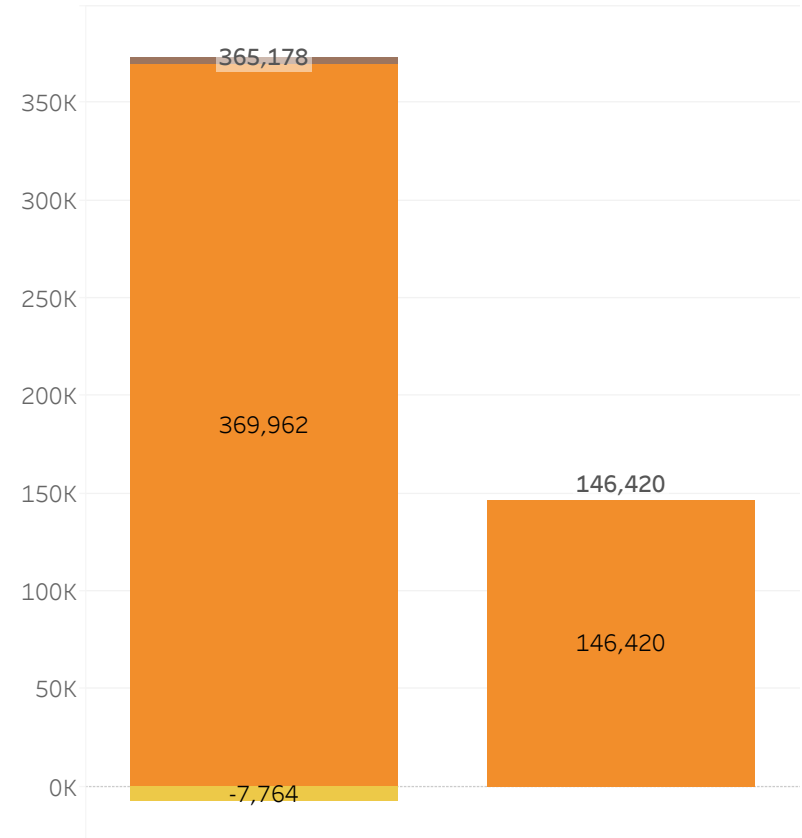

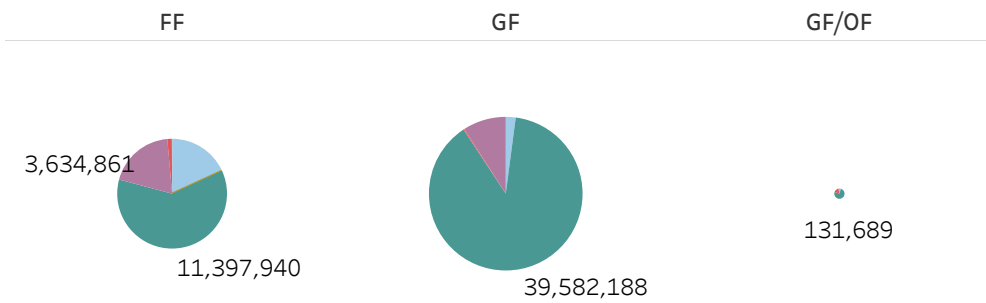
## DHHS Financial System Expenses

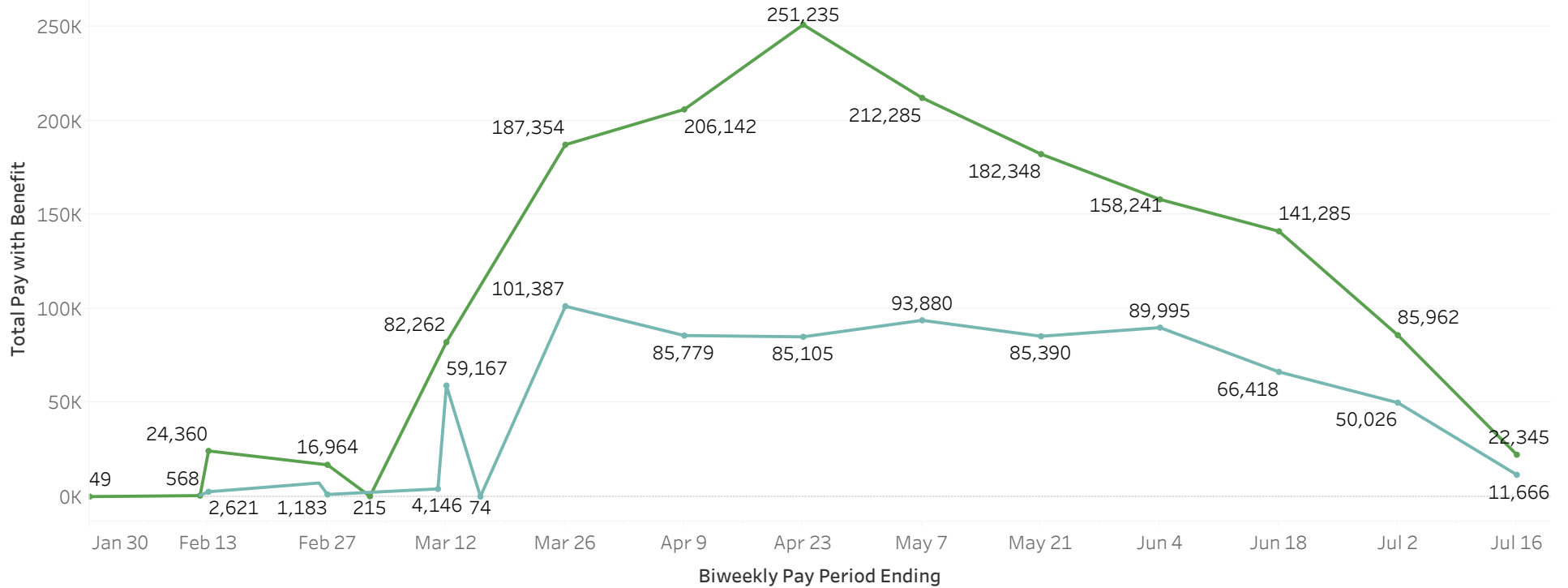
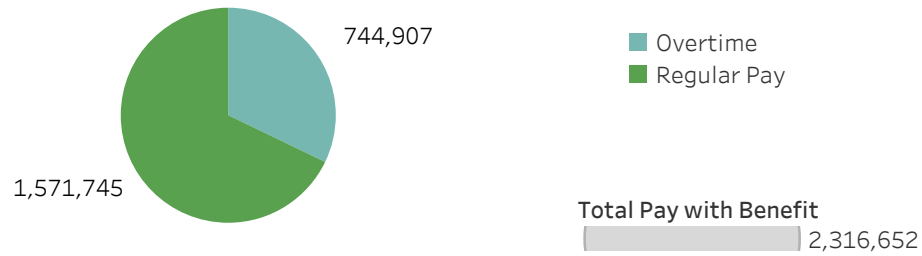
