Pursuant to my authority under RSA 21-P:43; RSA 4:45; RSA 4:47; and Executive Order 2020-04, as extended by Executive Orders 2020-05, 2020-08, 2020-09, 2020-10, and 2020-14 I have approved your written request, in attachment, to take the following actions related to the CARES Act Coronavirus Relief Funds:

1. Authorized GOFERR to reimburse the General Court of New Hampshire (General Court), vendor# 177870, Concord, NH, for eligible COVID-19 related expenses incurred from March 1, 2020 to June 30, 2020. Funds will be reimbursed through Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act Funding in an amount not to exceed \$190,355. Budgeted consistent with the information in the request in attachment, effective through December 30, 2020. (100% Federal Funds)
2. Authorize the General Court to accept CARES Act funding, in an amount not to exceed \$190,355, from GOFERR. Budgeted consistent with the information in the request in attachment, effective through December 30, 2020. (100% Federal Funds)

The Governor's Office for Emergency Relief and Recovery (GOFERR) requests authority to reimburse the General Court of NH, vendor# 177870, Concord, NH, for eligible COVID-19 related expenses incurred from March 1, 2020 to June 30, 2020. 

EXPLANATION

The Governor has authorized the emergency allocation and expenditure from GOFERR of \$190,355 to the General Court of NH. This represents reimbursement of unbudgeted COVID-19 related expenditures incurred by the General Court of NH, including but not limited to the professional disinfection of the State House and Legislative Office Building, purchase of computer equipment needed for staff to work remotely, and expenses related to Senate and House Session venue changes necessitated by COVID-19 restrictions.

All cost of business interruption due to COVID-19 must be incurred by the recipient before December 30, 2020.
