Pursuant to my authority under RSA 21-P:43; RSA 4:45; RSA 4:47; and Executive Order 2020-04, as extended by Executive Orders 2020-05, 2020-08, 2020-09, 2020-10, and 2020-14 I have approved your written request, in attachment, to take the following actions related to the CARES Act Coronavirus Relief Funds:

EXPLANATION

The Governor has authorized the emergency allocation and expenditure of \$1,540,900 to the New Hampshire Judicial Branch (NHJB) to cover eligible COVID-19 related expenses incurred from March 1, 2020 to December 30, 2020.

These funds are intended to support the NHJB's implementation of protocols within its court buildings and administrative office to keep both its staff and members of the public seeking access to justice safe through use of masks, hand sanitizers and disinfecting wipes, social distancing, health screenings and temperature taking. In addition, the NHJB is migrating to a remote work environment where practicable to help slow the spread of the virus, and allocated funds will support needed technological and telecommunications innovations. This appropriation will be used by the NHJB to backfill, as appropriate and allowed by the grant, the general funds used since mid-March. The remainder will be used during the coming months for expenditures directly related to COVID-19.

All costs of business interruption due to COVID-19 must be incurred by the recipient before December 30, 2020.
