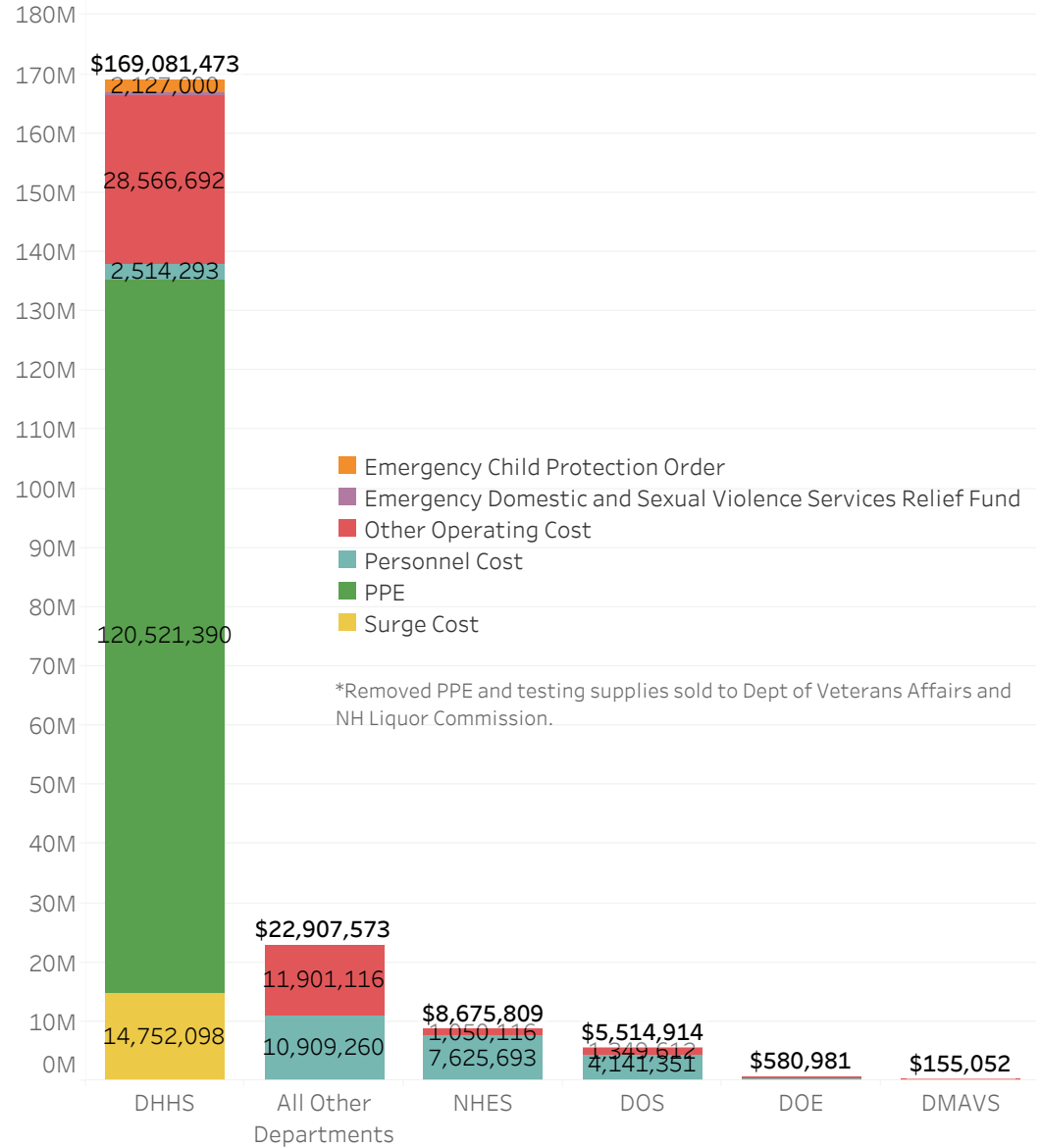

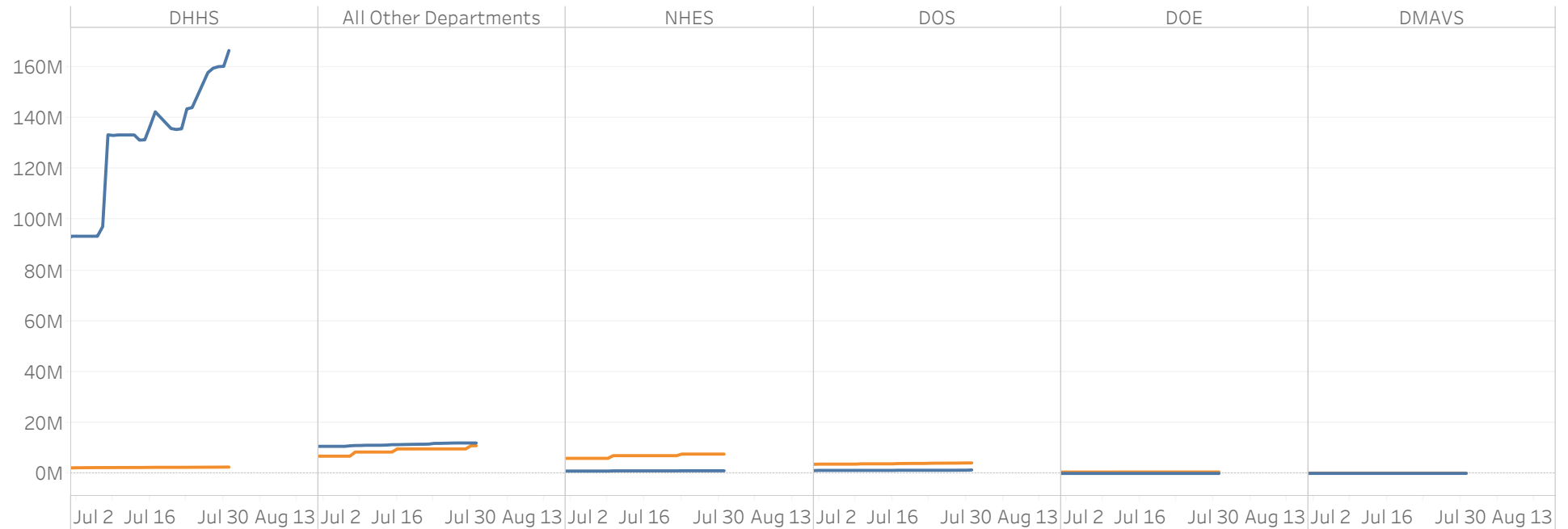

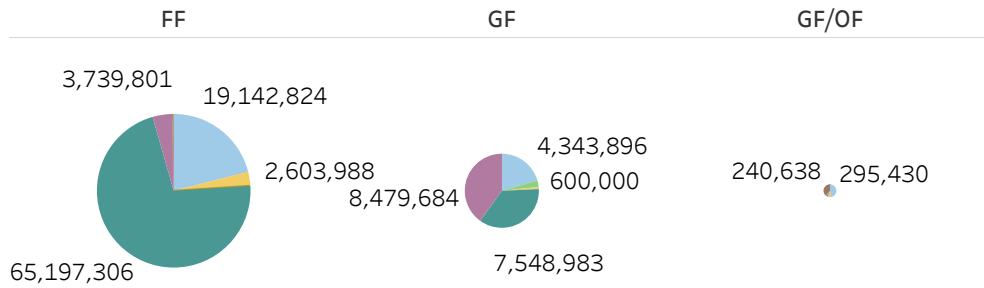

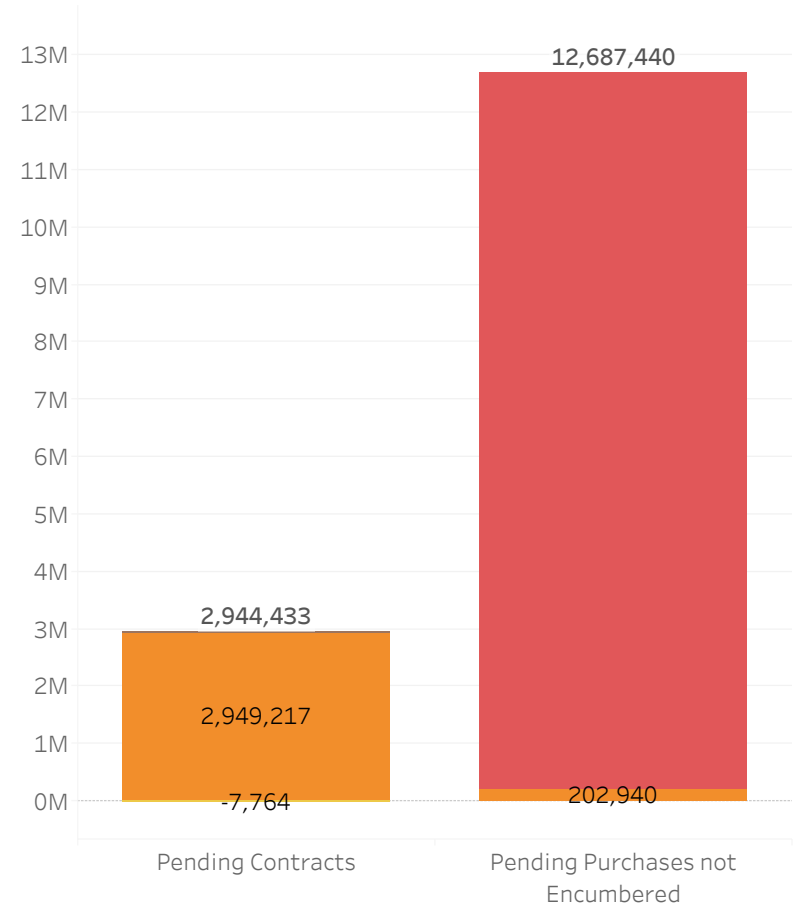

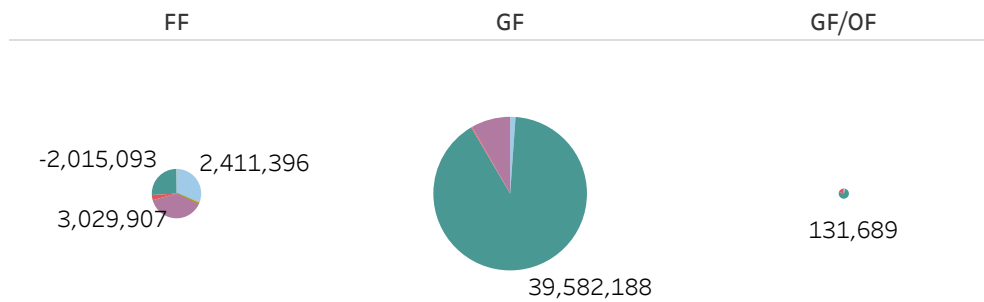
DHHS Financial System Expenses

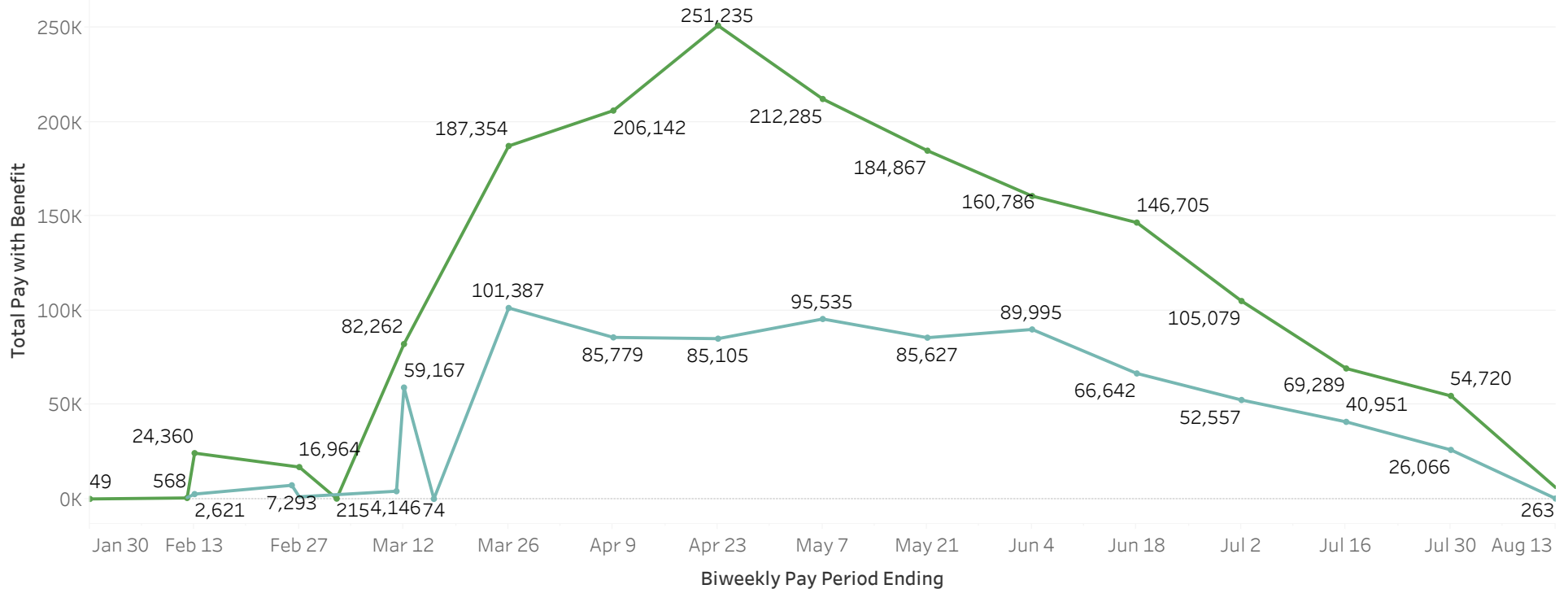
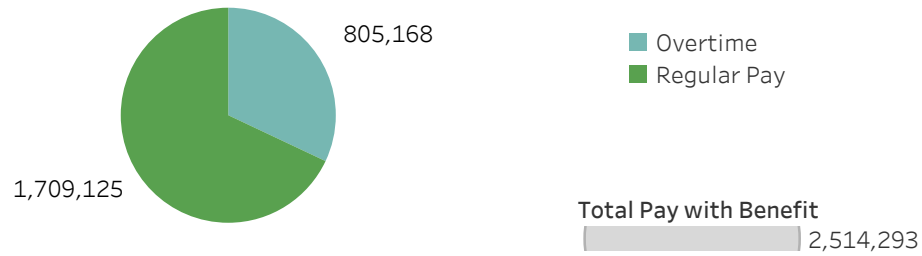
