Authorize the Department of Safety, Division of Emergency Services and Communications, to accept and expend federal pass-through funds in the amount of \$73,578.00 from the NH Department of Justice to support mobile video platform kits in support of COVID-19 testing sites and PPE distribution sites for first responders, effective upon approval through June 30, 2021. Explanation

These funds will be used by the Statewide Emergency Operations Center to receive and project multiple video sources using the fūsusONE platform. The fūsusONE platform uses secure, encrypted paths for data transmission conforming to the Criminal Justice Information Systems (CJIS) and HIPPA requirements. The fūsusONE system is rapidly deployable to various Alternative Care Medical Sites for situational awareness in support of Covid-19 testing sites and PPE distribution sites for first responders.

Funds are to be budgeted as follows:

Class 030 funds, Equipment, are needed for cameras, controllers, and foyers.

Class 038 funds, Technology-Software, are needed for software license for cloud management, user access, and storage.

In the event that federal pass-through funds become no longer available, General Funds will not be requested to support this program.
