Pursuant to my authority under RSA 21-P:43; RSA 4:45; RSA 4:47; and Executive Order 2020-04, as extended by Executive Orders 2020-05, 2020-08, 2020-09, 2020-10, 2020-14, 2020-15, and 2020-16 I have approved your written request, in attachment, to take the following actions related to the CARES Act Coronavirus Relief Funds:

- Authority to reimburse the NH Department of Safety (DOS), vendor# 177878, Concord, NH, for eligible COVID-19-related expenses incurred from April 10, 2020 to June 19, 2020. Funds will be reimbursed through Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act Funding in the amount of \$511,225. Budgeted consistent with the information in the request in attachment, effective through December 30, 2020. (100% Federal Funds)
- 2. Authorize DOS to accept and expend 511,225 from the GOFERR, budgeted consistent with the information in the request in attachment, effective through December 30, 2020. (100% Federal Funds)
