# REQUESTED ACTION UNDER RSA 21-P:43; RSA 4:45; RSA 4:47; AND EXECUTIVE ORDER 2020-04 AS EXTENDED BY EXECUTIVE ORDERS 2020-05, 2020-08, 2020-09, 2020-10, 2020-14, 2020-15, 2020-16, 2020-17, 2020-18 AND 2020-20

Authorize the Department of Health and Human Services, New Hampshire Hospital, to accept and expend funds from the Public Health and Social Services Emergency Fund (aka CARES Act) Provider Relief Fund in the amount of \$198,500 effective upon approval through June 30, 2021 and further authorize the allocation of these funds in the accounts below. This Relief Fund allocates CARES Act funding directly to healthcare providers for the sole purpose of prevention, preparation and response to the COVID-19. These funds are non-lapsing and transferable only within the accounting unit. 100% Federal Funds.

#### **EXPLANATION**
