Pursuant to my authority under RSA 21-P:43; RSA 4:45; RSA 4:47; and Executive Order 2020-04, as extended by Executive Orders 2020-05, 2020-08, 2020-09, 2020-10, 2020-14, 2020-15, 2020-16, 2020-17, 2020-18, and 2020-20 I have approved your written request, in attachment, to take the following actions related to the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency:

- 1. Authority for the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) to accept and expend federal funds in the amount of \$873,479 from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) to fund Immunization Programs, budgeted consistent with the information in the request in attachment, through June 30, 2021. (100% Federal Funds)
- 2. Authorize DHHS to create one temporary part-time position for immunization purposes budgeted consistent with the information in the request in attachment, through June 30, 2021. (100% Federal Funds)

#### **EXPLANATION**

On August 27, 2020, an award was made to the state by the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). The purpose of the award is to support program needs to focus on work for Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) vaccination planning and implementation. It will be instrumental in the development of state-wide plans with key partners for the distribution and administration of anticipated SARS-CoV-2 vaccine(s). Lastly, under the Vaccines for Children (VFC) Operations, non-COVID funding has been made available to support additional VFC education, training, and infrastructure needs for increased VFC services to support our health care provider practices during the current pandemic.

#### The funds are to be budgeted as follows:

Class 018	The funds will be used to pay overtime expense.
Class 020	The funds will be used to pay for current expense items.
Class 030	The funds will be used to pay for equipment.
Class 041	The funds will be used to pay for audit fund set aside.
Class 050	The funds will be used to pay for part time temporary positions.
Class 060	The funds will be used to pay for benefits.
Class 102	The funds will be used to pay for contracts.

The following information is provided in accordance with the comptroller's instructional memorandum dated September 21, 1981:

- 1. List of personnel involved: 1 part-time Vaccine for Children (VFC) Program Specialist III staff.
- 2. Nature, Need, and Duration: The position will provide for the increased needs caused by the COVID-19 public health event and the impact this has had on childhood/adolescent immunization coverage rates.
- 3. Relationship to existing agency programs: This is a new public health event.
- 4. Has a similar program been requested of the legislature and denied? No
- 5. Why wasn't funding included in the agency's budget request? At the time of budget submission, COVID-19 was not a known public health event and this funding opportunity had not yet been offered.
- 6. Can portions of the grant funds be utilized? All grant dollars are being used for this request.
- 7. Estimate the funds required to continue this position(s): Estimated costs: \$26,110.44.

Area served: Statewide

Source of Funds: 100% Federal funds from the Centers for Disease Control.

If Federal Funds become no longer available, General Funds will not be requested to support the program expenditures.
