Pursuant to my authority under RSA 21-P:43; RSA 4:45; RSA 4:47; and Executive Order 2020-04, as extended by Executive Orders 2020-05, 2020-08, 2020-09, 2020-10, 2020-14, 2020-15, 2020-16, 2020-17, 2020-18, 2020-20, and 2020-21 I have approved your written request, in attachment, to take the following actions related to the COVID-19 Global Pandemic:

1. Authority for the Department of Justice (DOJ) to transfers previously accepted Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funds (CESF) in the amount of \$554,000 between classes in order to make eligible grants to local governments, budgeted consistent with the information in the request in attachment, through June 30, 2021. (100% Federal Funds)

The Department of Administrative Services is authorized to take the actions necessary to effectuate this authorization.

Dear Governor Sununu:

Pursuant to RSA 21-P:43, RSA 4:45, RSA 4:47, and Executive Order 2020-04, as extended, the Department of Justice was authorized to accept and expend a grant, in the amount of \$3,454,070, from the Bureau of Justice Assistance, Office of Justice Programs, Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Fund (CESF), to prevent, prepare for, and to respond to the coronavirus.

CESF funds were budgeted based on estimated subgrants to Local Government/Non-Profits; Class 072 and State Agencies; Class 085. To date, the Department of Justice has received applications for funding from five State Agencies and 33 Local Government Offices, three with second funding requests. In order to encumber the funds awarded to Local Government Offices, a budget transfer is required in the amount of \$554,000, from Class 085 to Class 072. A budget adjustment memorandum has been submitted to the Bureau of Account via Stephen McLocklin in the Budget Office.
