- 1. Effective upon your through December 30, 2020. 100% Federal Funds

2. Contingent on Requested Action #1, authorize NHES to accept and expend \$30,000,000 from the GOFERR in support of the COVID-19 Long Term Care Stabilization Program established by Emergency Order #31, as modified, extended and reactivated by Emergency Order #45, #55, and #73. These appropriations will be budgeted as allocated below and will cover the period of eligibility of stipend amounts outlined the COVID-19 Long Term Care Stabilization Program. Effective upon your approval through December 30, 2020. 100% Federal Funds.

#### **EXPLANATION**

In response to the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency, on April 16, 2020, Governor Sununu issued Emergency Order #31 which established the COVID-19 Long Term Care Stabilization (LTCS) Program. The LTCS Program was to help stabilize the front line work not able to be conducted remotely by certain qualifying Medicaid providers. This program was modified by Emergency Order #45 on May 18, 2020 and extended by Emergency Order #55 on June 25, 2020, and reactivated on November 16, 2020 by Emergency Order #73.

Due to recent rise in COVID-19 cases in New Hampshire the program which includes providers that support aging seniors and people with developmental disabilities, as well as individual with mental health and substance abuse disorders, youth residential treatment providers, and developmental disability service providers who provide residential or community/home-based care. The program provides temporary stabilization funding to incentivize front line, direct care workers to remain or rejoin providers who support some of New Hampshire's most vulnerable person are able to provide continued services throughout the COVID-19 Emergency. Under the program, qualifying full-time front line employees will received \$300 per week and qualifying part-time front line employees will receive \$150 per week.

All CARES Act funds must be spent by the recipient by December 30, 2020.
