REQUESTED ACTION

Authorize the Department of Health and Human Services, Office of the Commissioner, to enter into a **Sole Source** amendment to an existing contract with Perry Plummer (VC#342039-B001), Dover, NH, for consultative services to support the State's strategic vaccination response to the COVID-19 pandemic, by increasing the price limitation by \$17,500 from \$87,500 to \$105,000, and by exercising a renewal option to extend the completion date from May 9, 2021, to June 6, 2021, effective May 9, 2021, upon Governor approval. 100% Other Funds.

The original contract was approved by the Governor on December 29, 2020, and presented to the Executive Council, as an informational item, on February 3, 2021 (Item #D), and most recently amended with Governor approval on March 3, 2021.

EXPLANATION

This request is **Sole Source** because the contract was originally approved as sole source and MOP 150 requires any subsequent amendments to be labeled as sole source. The Department, in the interest of the public's health and safety, originally identified a Contractor who could begin work immediately and possesses unique experience, logistical skills, and knowledge of Federal and State operations.

The purpose of this request is to continue to provide the Department with consultative services to support the State's strategic vaccination response to the COVID-19 pandemic. The Contractor assists with vaccine distribution planning; strategic assessment and resource allocation; communications and linkages with Federal and State contacts, healthcare organizations and providers, and other partners; and technical assistance with State Emergency Support Functions to ensure alignment with Department COVID-19 vaccination objectives.

As referenced in Exhibit A of the contract, the parties have the option to extend the agreement for up one (1) additional year, contingent upon satisfactory delivery of services, available funding, agreement of the parties, and appropriate State approval. The Department is exercising its option to renew services for three (3) of the twelve (12) months available.
