This request is being made to accept additional grant funds available for SFY 2021-2022 to administer the Coronavirus Aid, CRRSA Act, 2021 funding for LTC Ombudsman, SSA Title XX Section 2043(a)(1)(A) for Ombudsman Program. Funds are being budgeted in Program Contracts (Class 103) to provide funding to support preventing, preparing for and responding to Coronavirus Disease 2019 as well as to provide administrative relief for recipients and applicants of Federal Financial Assistance Directly Impacted by the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).
