



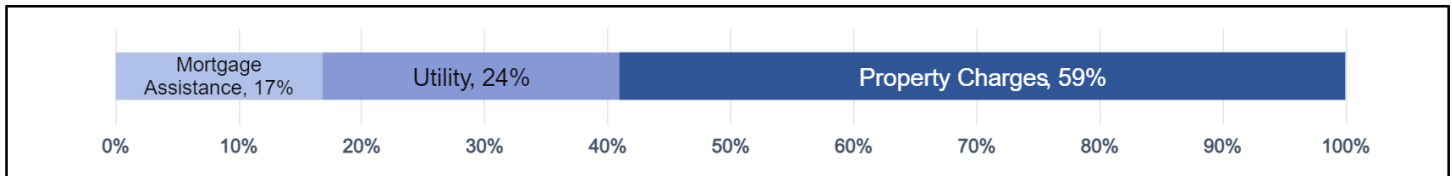
New Hampshire Homeowner Assistance Fund

Overview - As of September 26, 2022

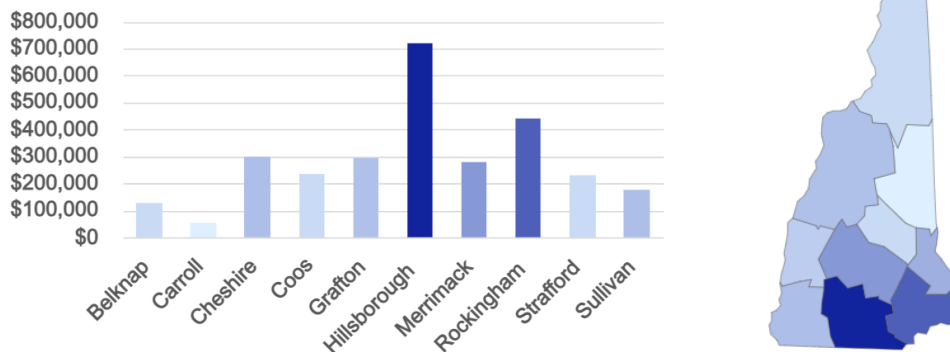
The New Hampshire Homeowner Assistance Fund began taking applications on March 8, 2022. NH Housing, the program administrator, has received 1,137 applications with 457 applications approved and 86 denied to date. Applicant households are from all ten counties and 187 cities and towns.

Assistance is available for past due bills including mortgage assistance, property taxes, association fees, and utilities. As of September 26, the majority of assistance has been provided for property charges (59%), followed by utilities (24%).
