



New Hampshire Emergency Rental Assistance Program

Overview - As of December 29, 2023

The New Hampshire Emergency Rental Assistance Program (NHERAP) began taking applications at noon on March 15, 2021. The Community Action Partnership (CAP) agencies received 33,244 applications with 31,464 applications approved and 1,780 denied to date. Applicant households are spread across 202 towns and all ten counties with a total of roughly \$302,480,357 being awarded so far, with the average amount provided being roughly \$10,542.

The assistance provided through the New Hampshire Emergency Rental Assistance Program (NHERAP) falls into five main categories rent, utilities, home heating, internet, and other expense. As of December 29, the majority of all assistance has been provided for purposes of rent, roughly 77%. NHERAP has also provided assistance for Utilities, Home Heating, Internet, and Other Expenses.
